Childcare

This Apprenticeship is designed for those who would like a career working with children.

Our Apprenticeships help Apprentices learn about child development, protection and enhance communication skills.

Early Years Practitioner

The Early Years Practitioner Apprenticeship is suitable for those looking to join the Children and Young People's Workforce or for those already working in the sector looking to gain a formal qualification.

This Apprenticeship will help Apprentices to develop their knowledge and skills relating to the Early Years sector.

Early Years Educator

The Early Years Educator Apprenticeship is designed to prepare Apprentices to become Early Years Educators, enabling Apprentices to work with children from birth to 5 years and gain knowledge of children aged 5 to 7 years.

Apprentices will develop and practice the skills required for employment and/or career progression in the Early Years sector.

Supporting Teaching and

Learning in Schools

This Apprenticeship will enable Apprentices to develop the knowledge and skills needed when supporting teaching and learning in primary, secondary or special schools.

It covers a wide range of areas including children and young people's development, supporting those with disabilities or special educational needs and communication and professional relationships.

Supporting Teaching and Learning in Physical Education and Schools

This Apprenticeship will equip Apprentices to deliver, plan, organise and assess the learning of children in a range of environments, including the community and schools.
