Fee Remission

You won't have to pay your course fees if:

- You are unemployed or earn less than £25,000
- You are in receipt of certain benefits
- You are aged 19-23 and are looking to study certain courses (subject to previous qualification)
- The qualification is on the Free Courses for Jobs list or is part of the Local Flexibility Offer

Financial Support
